



Lakeside Union School District
District Advisory Council (DAC)
January 14, 2019 Meeting

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order at 4:20 pm by Vice Chair Mr. Hefner in the absence of the Chair. Absent: representatives from Eucalyptus Hills, Lemon Crest, Lakeside Farms, a quorum was present.

Minutes from October 29, 2018 were presented, approved as read with no corrections.

Agenda Items Discussed:

- Assistant Superintendent, Erin Garcia gave an overview of the 2018-2019 budget per parent request from the October meeting. Ms. Garcia explained the budget approval process and timelines for the Board of Trustees, County Board of Education and the state of California. Additionally, explained how districts are now funded under the LCFF and LCAP and the difference between the general fund budget and restricted budget. Answered questions regarding funding the school lunch program, facility maintenance, upgrades and bonds.
 - Several parents asked questions about the target reserve balance. The Board of Trustees has given direction to maintain approximately 15% reserve.
 - This year the state gave one-time money to districts. Lakeside has used some of that to purchase a new school bus.

- DAC By-laws – Kelly Gilbert explained our by-laws are out of date, last updated in 1996. There have been some new laws and with different funding options some positions listed in the current by-laws no longer exist. Example “District Resource Teacher” is no longer a position; recommended changes to “Educational Services Coordinator” in all areas that list this position.
 - Recommended change to Membership article, section 2 Non-voting members will add “Superintendent or designee” and strike first sentence that includes Superintendent, Asst. Superintendent.
 - Under Article IV omit the specific months and replace with “meet four times per year in preferred months of November, January, March and June”
 - Discussed length of term for sitting on committee. Recommended new section to include term length of two years. This would match the requirements for School Site Council and give consistency to the committee and avoid the need to hold elections every year.
 - Parent rep Jerika Soule volunteered to type the new By-laws and share with Kelly in Googledocs. We will get them out to all members for review prior to next meeting.
