EARLY PRESCHOOL

Children ages 2-3 will begin their early education while we guide them through potty training; help to develop social skills and expand personal independence.

TRADITIONAL PRESCHOOL

Children ages 3-5 and fully potty trained get a head start on Kindergarten in an enriched environment that includes phonological awareness, letter and word recognition, emergent writing, mathematics along with play as an integral part of the curriculum.

SPANISH ENRICHED PRESCHOOL

Children ages 3-5 and fully potty trained will be exposed to Spanish in order to start early in their process of language acquisition and make a smooth transition into Lakeside Union School District’s school age full immersion or part time language programs.

STATE FUNDED PRESCHOOL

In this classroom the staff will work with children ages 3-5 and fully potty trained by offering an enriched environment including phonological awareness, letter and word recognition, emergent writing, mathematics along with play as an integral part of the curriculum. Children in this classroom must qualify by turning 3 years old by a yearly designated date. Four year olds will have priority in program openings. Enrollment is based on priority ranking not first come first served.

All Lakeside Preschool students are eligible to attend our before and after school programs located at the school site. The centers are open during the school year daily from 6:30 a.m. and operate until 6:00 p.m. Tuition is paid in advance on a monthly billing cycle. VACATION ENRICHMENT CAMPS*

Special interest preschool day camps operate on the Marilla Campus from 6:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. during non school vacation weeks. Each week campers experience visual and performing arts; craft projects, activities in science, experiences in cooking and nutrition, sports fun, weekly assemblies and fieldtrips.

>State Preschool Priority:

Eligibility for State Preschool is determined at the time of application and based on priority ranking, it is not first come first served.

Ⓢ Completed registration form on file for your child and emergency information must be kept current.

Ⓢ All tuition based preschool and childcare program registration fee and first month's tuition is payable at time of registration. Monthly tuition is due on the 10th of each month and children may be excluded from program due to non-payment on the 20th of each month. All checks are payable to "LUSD"
