School Reopenings & the Governor's "Safe Schools for All" Plan

- Governor Newsom's Safe Schools for All plan met with significant criticism
 - \circ $\,$ Feb. 1 deadline has come and gone not approved by legislature
 - Negotiations between Governor's office and legislature ongoing
 - Today: "A deal is imminent"
- CDPH updated guidelines in January
 - Nearly all of it already in place in LUSD from our previous Safe School Reopening Plan/COVID-19 Prevention Plan (PPE, Sanitation, Hygiene practices, etc.)
 - New: definition of "open"
 - Stricter rule re: spacing of students in the classroom (4 feet)

Vaccines

- Working with local health providers to see if vaccines can be made available soon to LUSD employees
- San Diego County Office of Education working with the County of San Diego on a possible mass vaccination effort for public school employees in San Diego County

Shift of instructional days for cohort A

- Feb. 15 "moved" to Feb. 17
- Feb. 22 "moved" to Feb. 24
- May 31 "moved" to June 1


How often are students and staff reporting **COVID+**?
