- How to craft a plan with input from parents and staff



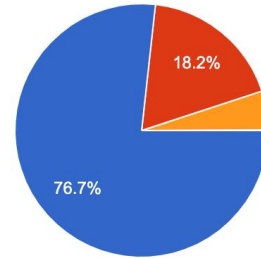
Parent Survey on Reopening Preferences


- OPTION 1: 100% In Class

Release date: **June 5, 2020**

Recommended effective date
no sooner than: **June 12, 2020**

All guidance should be implemented only with county health officer approval following their review of local epidemiological data including cases per 100,000 population, rate of test positivity, and local preparedness to support a health care surge, vulnerable populations, contact tracing, and testing.



Other considerations



- Procedures for bus riders
- Procedures for handling a positive COVID-19 case (student or staff member)
 - Notifying individuals who had contact - direct to quarantine and/or be tested
 - Notifying San Diego Department of Public Health
 - Broader notifications to staff and community
 - Sanitizing the area
 - Allowing return following Department of Health guidance
- Middle school schedule adjustments for stable groupings
- Maximizing physical distance in hallways, lunch areas, etc.

Distance Learning Committee

Ed Services Team, teachers, parent representative

- Considering lessons learned since March
- Reviewing parent feedback from town hall meeting and surveys
- Revising distance learning program with improvements
