

Lakeside Union School District Looks for One Bond Oversight Committee Member

The Lakeside Union School District seeks to fill one position on its Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee.

The seven-member committee oversees how Measure L, a \$31 million reauthorization bond, passed in 2014, is used. The bond pays for various facility improvements to the district's schools. The vacant position **shall be a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District.**

This appointee will serve a minimum of two years beginning October 2021. He or she will be eligible for up to two additional two-year terms. Applicants must reside within school district boundaries.

Applicants cannot be an employee or official of the district, or a vendor, contractor or consultant of the Lakeside Union School District. Those interested are encouraged to fill out and submit an application available on the district's website.

Applications can be submitted until noon September 30, 2021, and are available online at www.lsusd.net or at the District Administrative offices in the Business Department, 12335 Woodside Ave. Lakeside, CA 92040.

The committee meets four times a year, typically at 4:30 pm. at the district office.

Once applications are received, all eligible and qualified applicants will be reviewed by a screening committee. After screening is complete, selected applicants will be recommended for appointment by the LUSD Governing Board.
