- The reserves that RVCS has accrued over the last 10-15 years have floated the school in the wake of the pandemic
- The reserves are being depleted due to low enrollment
- Without the state and federal one-time funds, RVCS would be in the red
- Slight increases in enrollment are helping to close the funding gap, and measures are in place to increase enrollment to ensure a stable economic future

Enrollment Update

- Still experiencing low enrollment due to the pandemic
- P-2 ADA in 2023 was 223.41
- P-2 ADA in 2024 was 219.57
- RVCS ended the year with an enrollment of 230 students

Average Daily Attendance

7th Grade = 97.97%

8th Grade = 96.78%

9th Grade = 99.14%

10th Grade = 98.98%

Overall ADA for 2023-2024 = **98.61%**

- → Liam Rodriguez was name a National Merit Finalist through The CollegeBoard




Community Engagement
